

GEORGIA ASSOCIATION OF WOODTURNERS  
BOARD MEETING - November 18, 2010

The Board meeting was called to order by President Steve Pritchard. Present were Linda Britt, Jane McCravy, Danny McCravy, Harvey Meyer, Jim Hardy, Ron Britton, and Harry Saunders.

Minutes were presented by Linda Britt. A motion was made by Jane McCravy to accept minutes, with second by Danny McCravy. Motion passed.

Treasurer's report was presented by Jane McCravy. A motion was made by Linda Britt to accept the treasurer's report, with a second by Jim Hardy. Motion passed.

Steve passed around a letter from Jim Duxbury, who was the demonstrator in October, thanking the GAW for having him demonstrate.

The Holiday Party will be held at the December meeting. Members are asked to bring dessert and a turned item for each member of their party for the gift exchange.

Steve announced the recommendations from Suzi Tindall, who was the nominating committee. The floor will be open at the meeting for additional nominations. The elections will be held at the December meeting.
