Joe Womenski has been scheduled to do the January Demonstration. We will leave the Grinder and Wolverine Jig at Ga. Tech for them to use.

Denis Delehanty is to be reimbursed for the Deposit Slip and Dock Plate for a total of \$145.

Steve Pritchard asked if we could we find someone to replace him at the Perry Fair for receiving all entries.

We are still looking for someone to do the Demonstration at the September meeting.

Lawn Fish is doing the audio/visual for the September Symposium.

The meeting room at Ga. Tech will not be available until 6:00pm each month.

The Board Meeting was adjourned.
