

Executive Committee Meeting GAW

July 2, 2008

The executive committee of the GAW met at the Picadilly Cafeteria at noon on July 2. Attending the meeting: Nick Cook, Danny McCravy, Jim Hutchinson, Harvey Meyer, Steve Pritchett, and Suzie Tindall.

Minutes from the previous meetings were approved.

The treasurer's report: \$32,635.37 in checking account of which \$14198.70 is for scholarship. A detail of receipts and expenditures for the year was handed out.

Harvey Meyer discussed the Unicoi symposium plans. Currently there are 137 registrants and 58 spouses. The banquet count is at 213. Total last year was 245, with 250 at the banquet. The group decided to cut off preregistration at 260.

\$350 was approved for buying tapes for the video cabinet this year. Tape rental prices were discussed and it was decided to leave the rentals at \$2 each.

Discussion of the scholarship program was delayed until Harry Saunders returns to town in the fall.

A lengthy discussion regarding location sites for hands on classes took place. Jimmy Clews will be giving hands on classes in September. Possibilities for locations are three:

Steve Quail at Woodcraft in Roswell is setting up a turning facility with 8 Jet 1220 lathes when they move to their new facility. The earliest this facility will be available will be in October and it is not known how much the rent will be.

Mark Soleil is setting up a facility in Gwinnett which should be ready by September. His charge for rent will be \$100.

The group decided to try to contract with Mark Soleil for the hands on with Jimmy Clews in September.
